Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to grant parole to the petitioner for a period of eight weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contended and satisfied if he is permitted to file a fresh representation for parole to the concerned authorities and the said application be decided on its own merits without being influenced by the previous orders.

Prayer being innocuous is accepted.

Petition is disposed of with the liberty to make a fresh representation for parole/furlough before the concerned authorities. It is clarified that in case, such application is filed, the concerned authorities shall not be influenced by the previous orders and pass a speaking and reasoned order.
