These are the applications for placing on record a copy of letter dated 7.8.2018 as Annexure P-15, written statement on behalf of the respondents, and the reports regarding availability of requisite facility of Neuro Physician and the injection Botulinum Toxin Therapy for 'Focal Dystonia' writers Cramp received from different institutions at the stations referred to in order dated 30.9.2019 respectively.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed.

The documents mentioned above are taken on record.

Main Case (O & M) :

This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution
of India seeking issuance of a writ of certiorari for quashing the impugned

orders dated 3.2.2018 (Annexure P-10) qua the petitioner only and for quashing of order dated 9.2.2018 (Annexure P-11) and order dated 13.6.2018 (Annexure P-14). It is also prayed that directions be issued to the respondents to retain the petitioner in any other unit at Chandigarh or at any other place where the facility of applying the prescribed injection of botulinum toxin therapy at authorised centre under neurologist is available as per medical board dated 4.7.2016 (Annexure P-1) and dated 8.6.2018 (Annexure P-2) which has declared the petitioner Low Medical Category 3 Permanent for the deceased of Focal Dystonia (RT), for which the petitioner is under treatment at PGI, Chandigarh.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents have transferred the petitioner at a place convenient to him. Hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.

Miscellaneous Application, if any, also disposed of accordingly.
