Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case FIR No.20 dated 4.10.2018 registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station NRI, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

By virtue of the order dated 21.12.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have joined the investigation. He further submits that now the parties have amicably resolved the dispute and it is finally settled, thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has affirmed the fact regarding compromise.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh, has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 21.12.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
