Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0048 dated 29.06.2021 under Sections 406 and 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, District Roopnagar, SAS Nagar Mohali.

By virtue of the order dated 30.09.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.
