By this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated 02.06.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by the court of learned ACJM, Ludhiana, declaring him to be a proclaimed person in the context of FIR No.340, dated 01.12.2020, registered at Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 381/411 of the IPC.

The petitioner having been admitted to bail by the trial court and thereafter not having appeared constantly, though learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was in fact never issued notices for the specific dates which was also reflected in certain orders passed, however it is to be specifically observed in the order dated 12.10.2021 passed by the trial court, that the petitioner and his co-accused Inderjit Singh, who were earlier appearing in the case regularly and had knowledge of the case, seemed to be taking deliberate advantage of the covid situation.

The order admitting the petitioner to bail earlier is seen to be dated 01.06.2021.

Consequently, finding no merit in this petition, it is dismissed.
