By way of present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondents to grant benefit of increment to the petitioner by notional implication of last drawn salary and recomputed pension and other pensionary benefits and pay arrears of the same along with 18 per cent interest per annum.

Reliance has been placed upon CWP-32598-2019 titled as ***Gurdev Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another***, decided on 16.03.2022.

Notice of motion.

Mr. D.S. Sukarchakia, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Heard.

On perusal of the records, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3 to consider the legal notice dated 13.05.2022 (Annexure P-4), as representation moved by the petitioner and

decide the same in accordance with law keeping in view the judgment dated 16.03.2022 (Annexure P-3), by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no legal impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay within next two months thereafter, as per law.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
