[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 19.11.2019, in CWP No.23283 of 2018 in case titled as '**Hari Singh versus State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.23283 of 2018 was disposed of with a direction to the Executing Court, which was seized of the execution application for eviction of the unauthorized occupant from the shamlat land, to decide the execution application within six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that certified copy of order (Annexure P-1) dated 19.11.2019 was served on respondent No.3 on 12.06.2020 but till date, no action has been taken to decide the execution application.

[4] Although, notice has yet not been issued in the instant case,

learned DAG, Haryana, states that in compliance of order (Annexure P-1),

execution application has been decided and eviction of the unauthorized occupants from the shamlat land as complained of has taken place and possession of the encroached land handed back to the Panchayat after demolishing the three illegally constructed houses on said land.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned DAG, Haryana, no action is called for against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

[6] Contempt petition is accordingly *disposed of as such*.
