Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner No.1 is the legally wedded wife of respondent No.4 but at present, she is living with petitioner No.2, as husband and wife are having strained relations with each other. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners are apprehending threat from the hands of respondents No.4 to 10 and in this regard, representation Annexure P-3 has been given but the authorities failed to take any action on the basis of the said representation. Counsel for the petitioners further submitted that he will be satisfied if necessary action is taken by the authorities on the basis of the aforesaid representation.

Ms. Monika Jalota, DAG, Punjab appearing for the official respondents submits that in case any such representation is pending, the concerned authority will look into the matter and take action in accordance with law.

In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) to consider representation dated 6.8.2022 (Annexure P-3) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law in case there is any threat perception to the petitioners.

However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.4 to 10 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
