1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 05.04.2022, in CWP-17651-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 05.04.2022, reveals that claim of the petitioner for extraordinary family pension was allowed along with interest @ 6% per annum w.e.f. 03.08.1966 till date of release of the same, with needful to be done within one month.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that all benefits as per entitlement determined vide order Annexure P/1 dated 05.04.2022, in CWP-17651-2021, have been released to the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not

calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts
Act, 1971.
