Prayer in the petition is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 3 and 4 to provide the medical treatment to the petitioner, who is confined in Central Jail in case bearing FIR No. 103 dated 07.05.2019, registered under Sections 307, 353, 186, 224, 225 IPC read with Section 34 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Reply by way of affidavit dated 14.09.2022 of the Superintendent, Central Jail, Kapurthala, along with Annexures, already filed in the Registry, is taken on record. Para 4 of the reply is as under:-

4. That in this regard Medical report was sought from the Medical Officer of the Jail and the Jail Medical Officer has

submitted his Medical report bearing No. 5439 dated 09.09.2022, wherein it has been mentioned that the petitioner was sent to Guru Nanak Dev Hospital Amritsar on 08.09.2022 for treatment and any intervention, if required. The medical status report of the petitioner dated 09.09.2022 as received from the Jail Medical Officer is reproduced as under:-

“The patient was admitted in Jail on 10.05.2019. Patient, when admitted in jail gave history of fracture on right leg for which he had cast put on the leg. He came to Jail Hospital multiple times with different complaints for which he was treated by Jail Medical Officers time to time. He was even sent to Civil Hospital Kapurthala for treatment. Dates on which he was sent to Civil Hospital Kapurthala are 09.08.2022, 17.08.2022 and 03.09.2022. However, apart from it, medical treatment was prescribed at Civil Hospital Kapurthala on 16.308.2022 and 19.08.2022 but the Police guard had not come on that dates.

He was sent to Guru Nanak Dev Hospital Amritsar in orthopedics department on 08.09.2022 for treatment and any intervention, if required. Where at Ortho Unit-1, OPD, GMC Amritsar, his X-ray was done in radiology department. X-ray shows united fracture of Tibia (R) Upper 1/3’. Medicine was prescribed by the Doctor of Orthopedics Department Guru Nanak Dev Hospital Amritsar. Apart from it, Doctor of Orthopedics Department has written on the OPD Slip that : ‘No intervention is required.’ At present the patient is taking medication as prescribed by the Doctors of Orthopedics Department Guru Nank Dev Hospital Amritsar and the patient is in stable condition.”

As per the reply, the petitioner is being given proper treatment as per the requirements and if required, he is also taken to other hospitals outside the Jail.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of, as no indulgence of this Court is required in the present case.
