By this petition filed under Section 482 read with Section 483 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated 31.05.2018, passed by learned ACJM, Sri Muktsar Sahib, whereby he has been declared to be a proclaimed offender in case FIR No.24, dated 17.03.2016, registered at Police Station Sadar Sri Muktsar Sahib, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 420, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC.

As noticed on the last date of hearing, a reply has been filed by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Sri Muktsar Sahib, dated 23.02.2022, which was ordered to be taken on record on 23.02.2022 but with the counsel for the petitioner not available on 23.02.2022, hearing of the matter was deferred till today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition, with liberty to avail of his remedy before the trial court.

Dismissed as withdrawn. Obviously, such liberty can never be denied to an accused as long as he is availing of legal remedies.
