[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings
against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order,
Annexure P-2, dated 22.06.2020, in CWP No.8365 of 2020.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-2), reveals that CWP
No.8365 of 2020, was disposed of by directing the official respondents to
decide legal notice dated 13.09.2019 by passing a speaking order in
accordance with law within 02 months.

[3] Learned DAG, Haryana, refers to order (Annexure D-1)
dated 28.01.2021 / 02.02.2021, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as
contained in legal notice dated 13.09.2019.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the
circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant
petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to

challenge order (Annexure D-1) dated 28.01.2021 / 02.02.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[5] The same is not opposed to by the learned DAG, Haryana.

[6] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
