The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.67 dated 29.08.2019 under Sections 341, 323, 355, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 295 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station City Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated August 10, 2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated August 10, 2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated August 10, 2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
