The prayer in the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to issue an order/direction for directing the respondents especially respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents No.5 and 6. There is a further prayer to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.156 dated 05.08.2021 under Sections 447, 427, 511, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda, registered by respondent No.7 at the instance of respondents No.5 and 6.
