The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing of FIR No.007 dated 23.1.2020 registered under sections 498-A, 323, 376, 406, 506, 34 IPC at Women Police Station, Sonipat, District Sonipat along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 3.8.2021 (Annexure P-2).

This petition came up for hearing on 23.9.2021, however, no one was present on behalf of the petitioner. Thereafter notice was issued in this case on 10.11.2021. The case was being adjourned time and again either on request of counsel for the petitioner or on account of non-availability of counsel for petitioner. On the previous date of hearing i.e. 3.8.2022 last opportunity was granted to address arguments and the case was adjourned for today. Even today the proxy counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner has prayed for an adjournment on the ground that arguing counsel is not available.

Learned State counsel submits that in all there are five accused out of which challan has been presented qua four of them, whereas accused/petitioner no.4 is absconding. After completion of investigation challan has been presented and even charges have been framed.

Having perused the record, it is apparent that there is nothing on record to substantiate the compromise arrived at by the parties.

In view of the above position, present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to avail the alternate remedies as available to them in accordance with law.
