The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.160 dated 29.11.2021 (Annexure P-1), under Section 18 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station GRP Ambala Cantt., District Ambala.

The operative part of the order dated 17.08.2022, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“....It has been stated at the Bar that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR. It has been further stated that co-accused Satpal has been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by co-ordinate Bench vide order dated 07.01.2022 passed in CRM-M-324-2022.

Notice of motion be issued to the respondent-State of Haryana for 07.09.2022....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 17.08.2022, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Paramjit Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 17.08.2022 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
