The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.144 dated 24.06.2022 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506 IPC and Sections 325 and 452 IPC added later on at Police Station Raipur Rani, District Panchkula, Haryana.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 09.08.2022, petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jasvir Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 09.08.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on

joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
