This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents-authorities to absorb the petitioners into service and also pay them arrears of pay allowances w.e.f. 02.03.1994, 15.01.1994, 08.07.2002 and 05.02.2003 respectively and release the entire benefits together with interest @ 18% per annum to the petitioners as per their entitlement.

Learned counsel for the respondents has produced the judgment rendered by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in ***Ranbir Singh Vs. SK Roy, Chairman, Life Insurance Corp. of India and another, Miscellaneous Application No.1150 of 2019 in Contempt Petition (Civil) No.1921 of 2017 in Civil Appeal No.6950 of 2009, decided on 27.04.2022.***

In the opinion of this Court, the controversy involved in the present petition is clearly covered by the judgment rendered by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in the aforementioned case. Hence, this petition is liable to be dismissed.

In view of the judgment rendered by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in the aforesaid case, the present petition is dismissed.
