Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition was filed seeking grant of interest on the delayed release of pensionary benefits. Though, interest on the payments has been given to the petitioner but the calculation of the same is not to the satisfaction of the petitioner as the entitlement of the petitioner is much more than the amount, which has been awarded by the respondents themselves.

Learned State counsel submits that keeping in view the averments made in paragraph 8 of their reply, in case the petitioner has any grievance with regard to the amount of interest already awarded, the petitioner may raise the said grievance before the respondents by filing appropriate representation along with the calculation sheet with regard to the interest the petitioner is claiming for, which representation if made, will be considered by the respondents in a correct perspective and appropriate order will be passed within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of any such representation and in case, after the decision of the said representation, the

petitioner is found entitled for further financial relief, the same will also be released to him within a period of 4 weeks thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the aforesaid statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate representation before the respondents.

Ordered accordingly.
