MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for directing the respondents to grant four tier pay scales to the petitioners at par with Agriculture Development Officers and consequently apply multiplier of 2.59 while implementing revised pay scales in pursuance of 6th Punjab Pay Commission recommendations and entire arrears be paid to the petitioners along with 18% compound interest thereon.

At the outset, learned Senior Counsel on instructions from petitioners submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 30.05.2022 (P-11) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s) and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice dated 30.05.2022 (P-11) by passing reasoned order as per law within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioners would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.
