Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to consider and promote the petitioner as Lecturer Commerce w.e.f. 01.01.2022, when his juniors were promoted as such, along with all consequential benefits including arrears of pay, etc.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that instead of pressing the writ petition on merits at this stage, his client would be satisfied in case, representation dated 12.05.2022 (P-10) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Learned

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State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Director of Public Instruction (S.E.), Punjab, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation in accordance with law within a period of 02 (two) months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move appropriate application for revival of this writ petition.
