Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 23.09.2021 while issuing notice of motion, it was also ordered that during the pendency of the departmental appeal preferred by the petitioner, no deduction from the pension of the petitioner shall be made.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the aforesaid departmental appeal has been decided on 27.10.2021, which order has been impugned by the petitioner by way of CWP-24100-2021. As such no further orders are required to be passed in this case as the order dated 12.04.2021 impugned in the present petition, has merged with the appellate order dated 27.10.2021 and the *lis* would be determined in the subsequent petition, i.e. CWP-24100-2021.

Accordingly, he seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to pursue and continue with the cause of action in the other connected matter.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents has filed his power of attorney, which is taken on record.

He would submit that in fact on passing of the final order by the appellate authority this petition has been rendered infructuous. Further there is no objection to withdrawal of this petition to pursue remedy in the petition filed challenging the order passed in the departmental appeal.

Keeping in view the above and subsequent developments, this petition is liable to be disposed of as such.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
