Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that present petition was filed in the year 2018 and the petitioners will be satisfied in case, the respondents consider the claim of the petitioners for appointment in pursuance to the advertisement in which they competed. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that as per the petitioners, they are fully eligible but in case, the respondents have any objection with regard to their eligibility, the same be disclosed by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned State counsel submits that an appropriate order on the eligibility of the petitioners to compete for appointment in pursuance to the post advertised, will be considered and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order and in
