Fresh Power of Attorney on behalf of the petitioners has been submitted in the Court today and the same is taken on the record.

After arguing for a while, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition while submitting that the petitioners would surrender before the trial Court within one week positively and would move an application there for seeking the relief of regular bail and he further prays that the trial Court be directed to decide the bail application of the petitioners within some specific time frame.

Mr. Iqbal Singh Mann, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has appeared in this case in pursuance of the copy of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance, has no objection to the above-discussed submission as well as the prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having

been withdrawn with a direction to the trial Court concerned that in case the petitioners surrender before it within the afore-stipulated period and move any application for seeking the above-mentioned relief, the same be decided, in accordance with law, in the given set of the facts and circumstances of the case, within a period of three (03) days thereafter.
