[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 27.05.2022 in CWP No.11816 of 2022.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.11816 of 2022 was disposed of by directing respondent No.4 herein to consider representation dated 07.05.2022 and to pass appropriate orders in accordance with law preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the claim of the petitioner was found to be acceptable, then the needful be done forthwith and in case the same was not accepted, then a copy of order be supplied to the petitioner within a reasonable time.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that although notice has yet not been issued in the instant case and the instant case was filed on 08/09.08.2022, the respondents have decided the representation dated 07.05.2022 filed by the petitioner and released payment to the petitioner as per his entitlement, therefore, in the

circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
