The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.75 dated 24.07.2022 registered under Sections 420 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Chhajali, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he has paid amount of Rs.50,000/- to the complainant and the remaining amount of Rs.50,000/- will be paid within a period of 02 weeks.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Narender Singh, submits that in pursuance of order dated 10.08.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 10.08.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
