The petitioner is praying for anticipatory bail in CRA-98-2021 dated 29.12.2021, titled as '*Sunny Vs. State of Punjab*' in the case FIR No. 11 dated 09.02.2016 registered under Section 498-A and 406 IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was convicted under Section 498-A IPC. He has preferred an appeal and in terms of the order dated 29.12.2021, passed by the court of Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Court, Amritsar, the sentence awarded to the petitioner by the trial Court, was suspended on furnishing bail bonds within a period of 15 days. Bail bonds could not be furnished within the aforesaid time period and consequently, the trial Court has issued warrants of arrest against the petitioner.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail the alternative legal remedies as may be available to the petitioner under the law.

In view of the same, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
