[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 11.07.2022 in CWP No.18054 of 2021.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.18054 of 2021 and connected matters were disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file appropriate representations before the respondent-authorities within seven days from 11.07.2022 (i.e. upto 18.07.2022) with further direction that on receipt of said representations, the same be decided by the competent authority in accordance with law and it is only thereafter the petitioners if found covered under the Transfer Policy, be considered for transfers and further that appropriate order on the representations be passed and conveyed to those making the representations before effecting the general transfer for the Session 2022-23.

[3] Learned DAG has produced copy of speaking order dated 25.08.2022 rejecting the representation of the petitioner and holding him

liable to be transferred. Learned DAG further contends that the general transfers have yet not been effected and the same would be done only on the concerned employees giving an option by 31.08.2022.

[4] Faced with the aforementioned situation, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for liberty to challenge order dated 25.08.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
