Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case, the notice was issued on 10.08.2022 and the arrest of the petitioner was stayed by this Court. He further submitted that thereafter the petitioner has joined the investigation and has fully cooperated with the investigation process. He also submitted that in view of the aforesaid position, the petitioner may be granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

It has been specifically stated by Mr. Naveen S. Panwar, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, on instructions from S.I. Kashmir Singh that the petitioner has joined the investigation and has fully cooperated with the investigation process and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the specific stand taken by the learned State Counsel, the present petition is allowed. It is directed that in case at any

stage, the petitioner is required for further investigation/reinvestigation then the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation and shall also cooperate with the investigation process and in the event of arrest, he shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bond and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer and he shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
