This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondent No.1 to decide the claims dated 24.04.2016 under Section 33C (2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 in a time bound manner.

A perusal of the case file shows that most of the adjournments have been given on account of there being no Presiding Officer posted to man the Central Industrial Tribunal, Chandigarh. Therefore, no body can be held liable for those adjournments; on that count. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that now a regular Presiding Officer has been posted at the Central Industrial Tribunal, Chandigarh. Therefore, this Court has no reason to believe that the Tribunal would not proceed with the matter in the right earnest.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to interfere in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
