Prayer in this present petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner endangered at the hands of respondents No.5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the grievance, as has been raised, in the present writ petition, has also been raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 28.06.2022 (Annexure P-2), which is still pending consideration with respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran and the petitioner will be satisfied in case direction is given to the respondents to decide the said representation dated 28.06.2022 (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. H.S. Sullar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 28.06.2022 (Annexure P-2) by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Without going into the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition or in the representation, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the threat aspect and to decide representation dated 28.06.2022 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of with the abovesaid directions.

It is, however, clarified that this order shall not debar the State and/or any person(s) aggrieved from proceeding against the petitioners, if any cause of action arises or if they are involved in any other case.
