This is a petition that has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to remove the anomaly between the pay of senior and junior government employees according to notification dated 22.08.2019 (Annexure P-1) issued by Government of Punjab, Department of Finance, which has occurred due to the grant of ACP in the pay scales re-revised in the year 2011.

At the very outset, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that for the aforesaid grievance, the petitioner has already served a legal notice dated 16.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) upon respondent No.2, but no response has been received till date. He would submit that the petitioner would be satisfied in case said legal notice is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Deepali Puri, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the legal notice of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide legal notice dated 16.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order, in accordance with law, and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
