The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner as he has been summoned to face trial vide order dated 4.7.2022 under Section 319 Cr.PC in case FIR No.81 dated 12.03.2021 under Sections 302, 148, 149, 506, 120-B IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act registered at P.S. Ranjit Avenue, Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

On 06.09.2022 the following order was passed:-

“ The petitioner has been summoned to face trial as an additional accused under Section 319 Cr.PC. Similarly situated co-accused has been granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail.

Adjourned to 27.09.2022.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender

himself before the trial court within a period of one week from today and on his doing so he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.”

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that since he was found to be innocent during investigation and has been summoned to face trial under Section 319 Cr.PC his custodial interrogation is not required. Even otherwise, in terms of the aforementioned order the petitioner appeared before the Trial Court and has furnished his bail bonds to its satisfaction.

In view of the above, and the contentions raised by the counsel for the petitioner, the interim order dated 06.09.2022 is made absolute.
