1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/2 in CWP-13559-20212, in case titled as Ranbir Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another.

Pursuant to notice to respondent No.2, learned AAG, Punjab, has filed short affidavit of respondent No.2 along with copy of speaking order Annexure R1/T dated 13.12.2021, rejecting the claim contained in legal notice dated 22.04.2021. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same, states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, with liberty to challenge order dated 13.12.2021, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.
