1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 30.05.2022 in CWP-12052-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 30.05.2022 reveals that CWP-12052-2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider the objections filed by the petitioner in the light of decision in LPA No.1515 of 2015 besides, other relevant material and thereafter, finalize the ranking list.

3. Notice has yet not been issued in the instant petition. However, Mr. D.S. Nalwa, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.2 and 3 has produced copy of office order No.792/M-470/2021/Vol-II dated 16.09.2022 rejecting the objections filed by the

counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order dated 16.09.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
