[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 13.07.2021, in CWP No.12543 of 2021 in case titled as '**Ami Lal Choyal and others**versus**State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.12543 of 2021 was disposed of vide order dated 13.07.2021 by directing the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioners as per legal notice dated 28.02.2021 and also by keeping in view the contentions raised in the writ petition and take a decision in respect thereto in accordance with law within three months.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that claim of the petitioners as contained in legal notice dated 28.02.2021 has been rejected vide order dated 17.08.2022, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition but pray for liberty to challenge order dated 17.08.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
