This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to properly investigate the FIR No.0200, dated 07.09.2021, under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City-1, Abohar, alleging that the police is intentionally and deliberately not added the main accused in the FIR and that the medical record shows that there was a serious head injury on account of which, according to the learned counsel for the petitioner, Section 307 of the IPC ought to have been added.

Notice of motion.

On the asking for the Court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

It transpires from the perusal of the petition that a representation Annexure P-3 dated 08.01.2022 was submitted by the petitioner to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, which has yet not been decided.

Mr. Dayal, on instructions from ASI Bahadar Singh, who is present in Court, does not dispute this position.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will be satisfied if respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation of the petitioner dated 08.01.2022 (Annexure P-3) and take a decision thereon.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel of the petitioner and without going into the claim raised by the petitioner, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation Annexures P-3, dated 08.01.2022, in accordance with law.
