1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 02.03.2020, in CWP-5864-2020.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 02.03.2020, reveals that while issuing notice of motion for 15.04.2022, operation of order dated 31.01.2020 and the result of election which was held on 03.02.2020, was stayed till further orders.

3. Reply dated 05/06.09.2022 has been filed by the learned AAG, Punjab. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of reply filed by respondent Nos.3 to 5, meeting of the Managing Committee was held on 02.09.2022, under the Chairmanship of petitioner No.1, therefore, the orders of this Court Annexure P/1 dated 03.02.2020, having been complied with, the petitioners do not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
