Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was invalidated from service in the year 1976 on the medical ground but no benefit of invalidated pension was granted to him. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though there is a delay in approaching the Court but, as the pension is a continuing claim, which cannot be denied on the ground of delay, the claim of the petitioner is still valid for the grant of invalidated pension. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 22.09.2021 (Annexure P-2). Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the representation has been addressed to the Home Minister, Govt. of Haryana, Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh but a copy of the same has already been sent to the Director General of Police, Haryana as well as to the Deputy

Commissioner of Police, Gurugram and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 3 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 22.09.2021 (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the representation, respondent No. 3 is directed to decide the representation dated 22.09.2021 (Annexure P-2), by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
