In the present petition, the challenge is to the action of the respondents in not allowing the petitioner to complete 05 years' service at the current place of posting, which according to the petitioner is a mandatory requirement for consideration of an employee for transfer under the transfer policy dated 01.06.2017 (Annexure P-2) which has been issued by the respondents for effecting transfers.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, the grievance of the petitioner is with respect to compulsory participation of the petitioner in the transfer policy for the Session 2022-23, though, as per the petitioner, he is yet to complete 05 years of service at the present place of posting.

He submits that the grievance which has been raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner by filing appropriate representation and the proof of the same has been attached as Annexure P-4 with the petition, wherein, the grievance raised by the petitioner has been noticed as ticket No. 210984-75941, which grievance is still pending

consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage if time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the court, Mr. Harish Nain, A.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

He submits that the grievance of the petitioner will be redressed within a period of three weeks' from the receipt of the copy of this order if not already redressed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed.

Ordered accordingly.
