By this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.126, dated 16.05.2018, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, Amritsar, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 452, 323, 427, 148 and 149 of the IPC, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise (copy Annexure P-2), arrived at between the petitioners and respondents no.2 to 5.

Pursuant to the order dated 15.01.2021, the report of the learned JMIC, Amritsar, dated 15.02.2021, has been received, stating therein that the petitioners as well as respondents no.2 to 5 got recorded their statements that they have compromised the matter with each other without any pressure, coercion or influence.

The statement of the police official ASI Sushil Kumar was also stated to have been recorded to the effect that there is no other criminal case registered against any of the parties and none of them have been declared as

proclaimed offender.

That being so, looking at the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioners and the fact that the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and respondents no. 2 to 5 and the report dated 15.02.2021 of the learned JMIC, Amritsar, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.126, dated 16.05.2018, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, Amritsar, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 452, 323, 427, 148 and 149 of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
