AMAN CHAUDHARY, J.

The prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.271 dated 29.5.2022, registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 34 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Adarsh Nagar, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of order dated 22.8.2022 of this Court, the petitioner has not only joined investigation but has also fully cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel affirms the factum of joining the investigation by the petitioner and cooperating with the investigation agency. He also submits that at this stage, the petitioner is not required for further custodial interrogation.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and has fully

cooperated with the investigating agency; this Court is of the considered opinion that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not warranted.

In view of the above, the order of this Court dated 22.8.2022, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it is made clear that if the petitioner fails to join and cooperate with the investigation agency as and when required, the State would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of the present anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner.
