[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-4, dated 02.03.2022, in CRM-M No.8782 of 2022 in case titled as '**Shiv Dass Kumar** versus **State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-4), reveals that CRM-M No.8782 of 2022, was disposed of vide order dated 02.03.2022, by directing the respondent that in case any representation was filed by the petitioner raising any grievance, the same be decided within eight weeks.

[3] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case.

[4] However, learned Asstt. AG, Punjab, has produced copy of speaking order dated 21.04.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the

petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge speaking order dated 21.04.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
