Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.273 dated 21.10.2019, registered at Police Station Ateli, District Mahendergarh, under Sections 323, 506, 34, 120-B IPC and Sections 454 and 380 IPC (added subsequently).

Copy of status report dated 24.02.2022, by way of affidavit of the Additional Superintendent of Police, Mahendergarh, District Mahendergarh, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, assisted by the learned counsel for the complainant, submits that as per para 19 of the petition, the petitioner is not involved in any other case except for the present case, whereas as a matter of fact, he is involved in two other cases i.e. FIR No.291 dated

18.10.2018, under Sections 506 and 34 IPC, Police Station Ateli, and a Kalandra under Sections 107/151 Cr.P.C. He, thus, submits that the petitioner has not approached this Court with clean hands.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has already mentioned in para Nos.5 and 6 of the petition with regard to other cases pending against the petitioner. However, he seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
