It has been informed by learned State counsel that in the present case Special Investigating Team (SIT) had been constituted to look into the matter and upon inquiring into the matter, the petitioner has been found innocent and is not sought to be arrested.

In view of the aforestated position, the instant petition filed under provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail is rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

Since, the FIR has not been cancelled so far by the Illaqa Magistrate, therefore, it is directed that in case ever at a later stage, the Investigating Agency seeks to arrest the petitioner upon finding any other

piece of evidence, the petitioner shall be afforded 1 week’s prior notice before effecting his arrest.
