RAVI SHANKER JHA, C.J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the parties conjointly submit that in view of notification dated 15.07.2021 issued by the respondent-authorities under the provisions of Section 93(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013, the land acquisition proceeding in respect of 1 kanal 17 marlas of land falling in khasra No.4//24/1 of Village Dhode Majra, Tehsil Kharar, SAS Nagar has been withdrawn and, therefore, nothing further survives for adjudication in the petition.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the petition stands dismissed as infructuous leaving all other questions which have been raised in the connected petitions open for adjudication.

Since the main case itself has been decided, no orders are required to be passed in CMs-13-14-CWPIL-2021.
