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Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Claim petition was filed by the parents of the deceased, wherein learned MACT held respondent No.3-National Ins. Co. liable to pay the compensation.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for Respondent No.3-Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.4,50,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants in full & final settlement of the claim. Counsel further stated that the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.2-Smt. Gyarshi W/o Lal Chand, for & on behalf of all the appellants.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to Respondent No.3-Insurance Company to deposit cheque in the sum of Rs.4,50,000/- favouring appellant No.2-Smt. Gyarshi W/o Lal Chand with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 22.03.2022. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
