Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was selected as Workshop Attendant under the category of sports person but, as a fresh gradation certificate was required for and the same was duly applied for by the petitioner, pending which, his services were terminated by the Principal concerned vide order dated 20.01.2021 (Annexure P/9) on the ground that the gradation certificate has not been submitted by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already applied for issuance of the gradation certificate as per policy dated 25.05.2018 (Annexure P/6) but, the respondent-Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, who is to issue the said certificate, has not issued the same, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the

respondent-State.

Mr. Mukul Aggarwal, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1,2,9 & 10.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the assertions of the petitioner as raised in the present petition is incorrect as in order to be selected, the candidate was required to have gradation certificate from the Government of Haryana, which certificate though, applied by the petitioner but his request has been rejected vide order dated 09.02.2021 (Annexure P/11) by the respondents on the ground that the said event on the basis of which, the petitioner was claiming gradation certificate is not covered under the policy dated 25.05.2018 (Annexure P/6), copy of the said rejection order has been appended by the petitioner himself with the present writ petition as (Annexure P/11).

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition may kindly be disposed off having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition challenging the order dated 09.02.2021 (Annexure P/11).

Ordered accordingly.
