In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioners is to hold the election of the respondent No.7-Society, which are already due but, could not be held.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case the elections are due, the same will be held in accordance with law, for which, some time be given to them so that election programme and other formalities needed to be completed could be done. Learned State counsel prays for four month's time to hold the election of the respondent-Society.

Keeping in view the above, the present writ petition is disposed off with the direction to the respondent-State to hold the election of the respondent No.7-Society by following due process as envisaged under law

within a period of four months as requested by the respondent-State. In case, petitioners have any grievance with regard to the voter list, the respondent-State is directed to look into the said aspect also in case, the same is raised before the authorities concerned.
