In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that he be considered for appointment on contract basis keeping in view the Advertisement, which was issued by the respondents in the year 2016 for appointment against the post of Trade Mechanist.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was fully eligible and had applied for the same but nothing has come on record as to why, he was not considered for the said contractual appointment. The prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to consider his claim for contractual appointment in respect of the Advertisement, which was issued in the year 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated

12.03.2019 (Annexure P-6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 3 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 12.03.2019 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the representation, respondent No. 3 is directed to decide the representation dated 12.03.2019 (Annexure P-6), by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
